Professional Experience

After practicing structural engineering for eight years with various firms in Honolulu, Mr. Kawaharada joined Englekirk Structural Engineers in 1979. He served as a Project Director, and was appointed the Hawaii Division Manager and Vice-President of the company in 1982, and became a partner in 2000.

Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Kawaharada served as Senior Project Engineer on such projects as The Grosvenor Center, Honolulu (a 30-story office building), The Hyatt Regency, Maui (a 750 room hotel) and The Marriott Maui (an 800 room hotel). In his present position, he has directed numerous projects, diverse both in scale and type, working with Architects, Builders, Developers, and fellow consultants to find economical and appropriate solutions to structural problems for both new and rehabilitation projects.

Mr. Kawaharada was a lecturer at the University of Hawaii School of Architecture from 1979 to 1999, teaching the course "Advanced Structural Design in Architecture," and is a licensed Structural Engineer in the State of Hawaii (license #4138S, August 1976).
